

# Comments and correction of data

- 36 MS requests to correct their species data, 34 performed (not possible to update maps)
- 14 MS requests to correct their habitat data, 11 performed (not possible to update maps)
- 195 Comments for species
- 184 Comments for habitats
- **25%** of comments addressed the regional assessment performed by ETC/BD
- **75%** of comments addressed the MS assessments performed by countries
- 5% of comments were taken on board by changing the regional assessment
- 70% of comments were integrated in the “Data Sheet Info”
- 25% of comments were not relevant and reason provided



# Users commenting in the web tool

4 MS National Data Coordinators:

- DE: 33 species / 23 habitats (only comments)
- FI: 6 species / 3 habitats (only corrections)
- HU: 3 species / 1 habitat (only corrections)
- SK: 1 species (only corrections)
