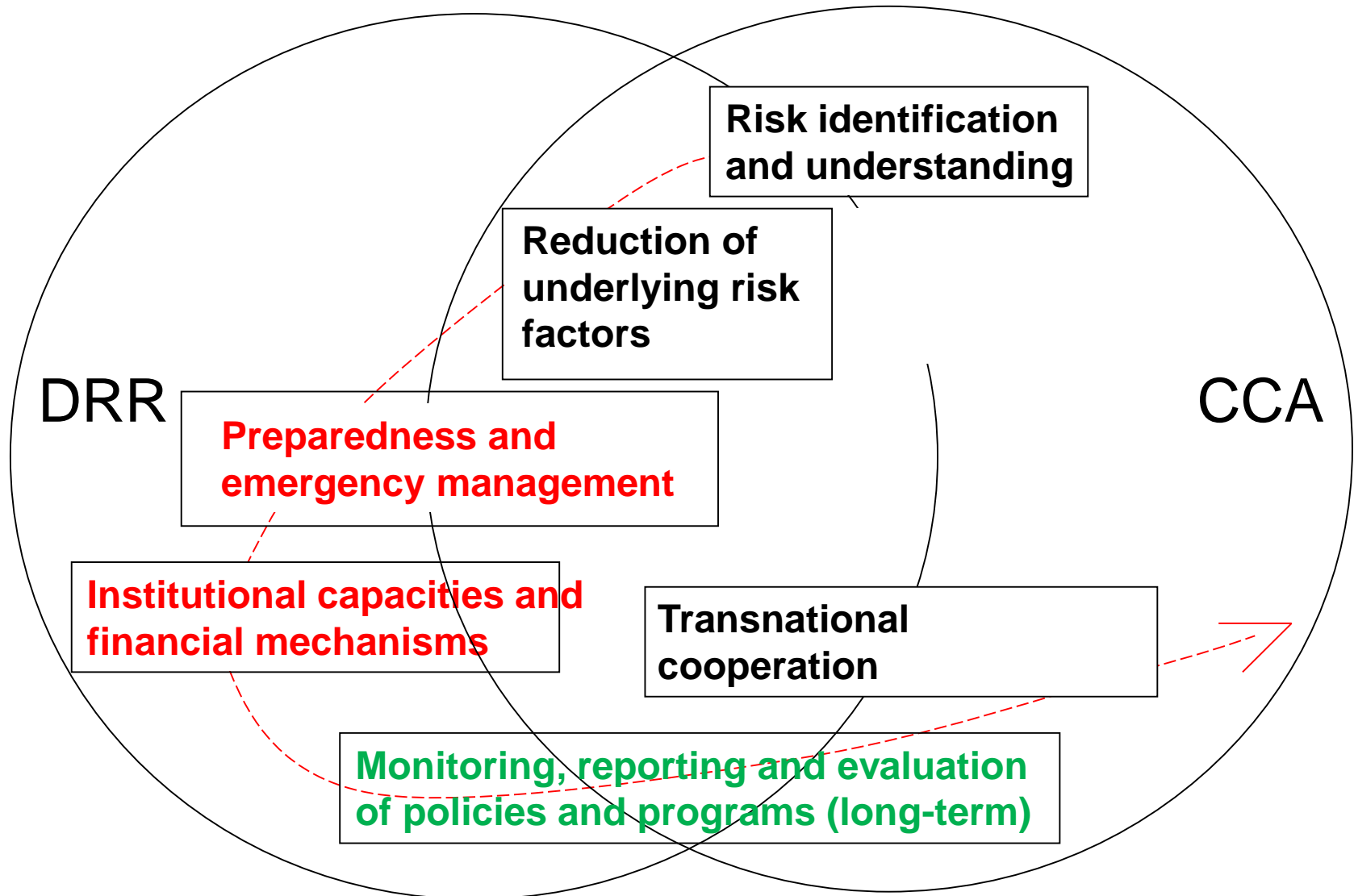
CCA methods and tools (key topics)

- Public and policy awareness of the need for adaptation
- Knowledge generation and use
- Planning and coordination of adaptation
- Stakeholder involvement
- Transnational cooperation
- Monitoring, reporting and evaluation of policies

DRR methods and tools (key topics)

- **Risk identification and understanding**
 - Risk and vulnerability assessment
 - Hazards and risk (evolution) monitoring
 - Multi-Risk Assessment / Cost-Benefit Analysis
 - Public awareness to stimulate a culture of resilience
- **Reduction of underlying risk factors**
 - Mainstreaming DRR into development policies and planning, building codes, etc.
- **Preparedness and emergency management**
 - Disaster and preparedness plans, EWS, information exchange
- **Institutional capacities and financial mechanisms**
 - Strengthening of governance, capacity building, funding, community participation
- **SFDRR (new)**:
 - **Transnational cooperation**
 - **Mechanisms, criteria and indicators for monitoring of national policies**
