



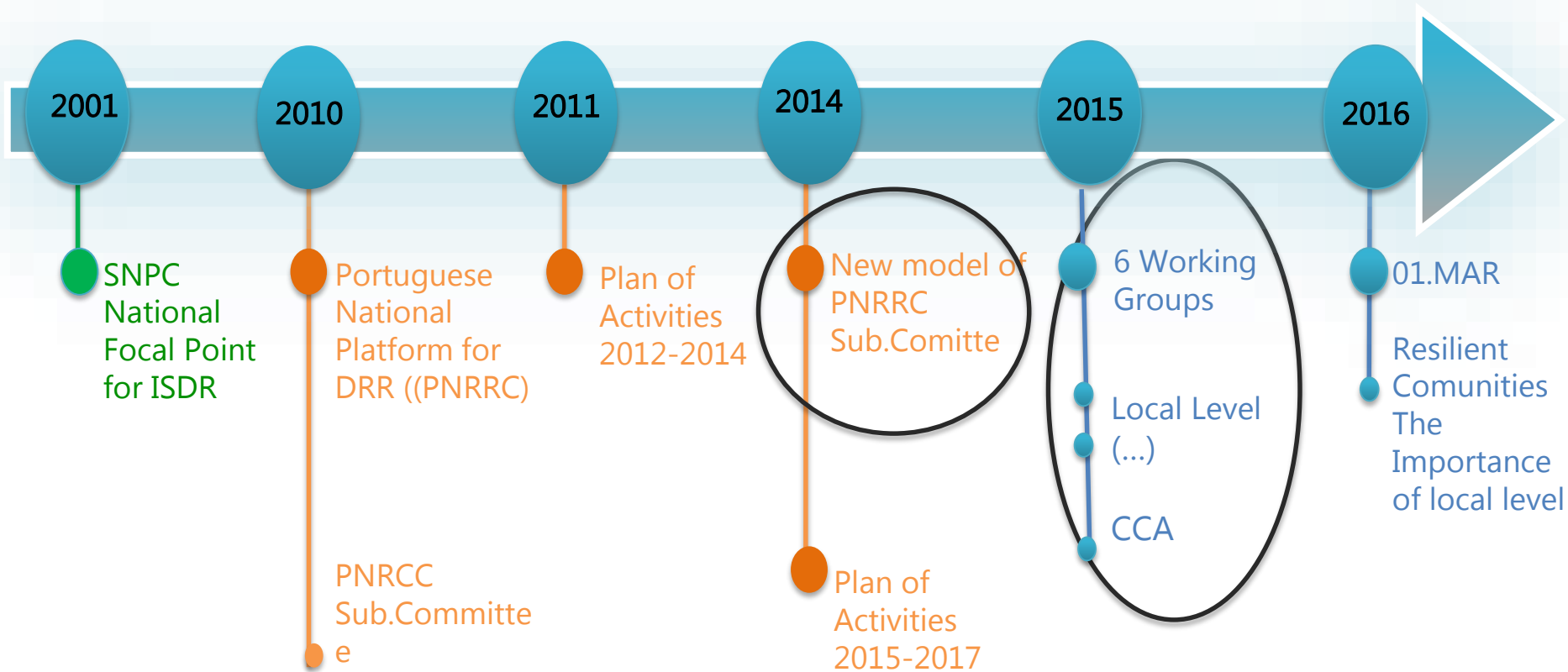

Local Strategies for Adaptation Network of municipalities

- **Exchange of Experts in Civil
Protection Programme**

Prevention

- Inclusion of areas of high and moderate risk susceptibility in regulation of the Master Plan;
- Intervention in water courses

- Municipal Emergency Plans (*all hazards*) – local risk assessments
- Specific Emergency Plans: floods; forest fires; adverse weather; Contingency Plan for Heat Waves and Cold weather;
- Exercises and drills

Monitoring and EWS

- Municipal integrated system for weather prevention;
- Briefing operational reports at local level: information on weather forecast and warnings, UV's index, civil protection, and health
- Disaster loss data: *“Events History in the municipality of Amadora 2000-2010 alerts”*.

- Information to the population;
- Sessions to children and schools;
- Leaflets;
- Social media to provide information on weather forecasts and warnings and self-protection measures;

Key factor

- Mobilization of several stakeholders; civil protection agents; municipality services, parish councils and citizen groups;

- Promotion of **exchange of good practices** DRR/CCA at local, national and EU level
- Involvement of stakeholders: **local platforms** for DRR/CCA
