

## HOW TO GET TO THE AGENCY?

### Travel information:



### From the airport by Metro

There is a direct Metro connection from the Copenhagen Airport to Kongens Nytorv (where the EEA is located). You can find the Metro station in the airport by walking straight ahead from the baggage reclaim exit to the main lobby in Terminal 3. Do not deviate right to taxis or left to busses or down to regional trains. Just go straight ahead and up the stairs or elevator following the Metro signs. The travel time to Kongens Nytorv is approx. 15 minutes. The Metro operates at 4-6 minutes' intervals during the day and evening hours and every 15 minutes during the night. The Metro operates from five o'clock in the morning until midnight. (Thursday – Sunday the Metro operates round the clock).

### Tickets

Tickets for the Metro can be purchased from the ticket machines at the Metro station and at the DSB ticket sales counter in Terminal 3. You need a 3-zone ticket (approx. DKK 30.00 (~ EUR 4.03)).

Please note that the ticket machines do not accept notes, only coins and cards such as the Dankort, VISA, etc. For a detailed trip plan you can use [www.rejseplanen.dk](http://www.rejseplanen.dk) or [www.m.dk/en/welcome/route.htm](http://www.m.dk/en/welcome/route.htm).

For more frequent usage of Copenhagen public transportation, you may purchase a ticket allowing multiple trips (a stamped ten-trip card covering 3 zones at DKK 160 (~ EUR 21.50)).

When you get off at Kongens Nytorv, walk from the Metro station (marked "M" on the map) to the EEA premises (the blue dot) – a two minute walk.

The map shows the area around the EEA offices, including Kongens Nytorv Metro station (M). EEA ● is just on the opposite side of Krinsen.



### Currency information

1 EUR = 7.5 Danish Kroner (DKK). There is an ATM and currency exchange office to your left after you pass through customs in the airport.
